Any enterprise with an **annual total revenue of R10 million or less, or is a recently formed or incorporated entity that has been in operation for less than one year (start up enterprise)** would qualify as an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME). EME's are deemed to have B-BBEE Status of "Level 4 Contributor" having a B-BBEE procurement recognition of 100%.

If an EME is 51% or more than 51% ,black owned, it is elevated to have a "Level 2 Contributor" having a B-BBEE procurement recognition of 125%.

If an EME's is 100% black owned, it is elevated to have a "Level 1 Contributor" having a B-BBEE procurement recognition of 135%.

51% or more than 51% Black Owned means an entity in which:

- black people hold 51% or more than 51% of the exercisable voting rights
- black people hold 51% or more than 51% of the economic interest
- has earned all points for Net Value

Black = African, Colored , Indian and Chinese South African Citizens

Black individuals has the meaning defined in the Act qualified as including only natural persons who are citizens of the Republic of South Africa by naturalization.

- Occurring before the commencement date of the constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act of 1993; or
- Occurring after the commencement date of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act of 1993, but who, without the Apartheid policy would have qualified for naturalization before then.
